

**CITY OF HAZELWOOD
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 22, 2021**

CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the Hazelwood City Council was called to order by Mayor Matthew G. Robinson at 6:01 p.m. on Wednesday, September 22, 2021, in the Council Chambers of Hazelwood City Hall, 415 Elm Grove Lane.

There being no amendments proposed, Mrs. Singleton moved, seconded by Mr. Aubuchon, the adoption of the agenda as printed. The motion passed unanimously.

SECOND READING OF BILLS AND ACTION ON BILLS

**BILL 4959
2021 TAX RATES**

Mayor Robinson called for the second reading of Bill 4959 to establish the 2021 ad valorem tax rates.

Assistant City Manager-Finance David Tuberty stated the county assessment tables Post Board of Equalization numbers were posted on September 15, 2021. The rates for commercial changed since the September 15, 2021 Council meeting and are reflected in the amended bill.

Mr. Aubuchon moved, seconded by Ms. Matlock, to amend Bill 4959 by the text of Bill 4959.1. The motion passed.

There were no objections and Bill 4959, as amended, was read by title only:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL RATE OF AD VALOREM TAXES LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2021 FOR GENERAL AND OTHER MUNICIPAL PURPOSES ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF HAZELWOOD, MISSOURI, AND THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE CITY'S SEWER LATERAL SERVICE LINES REPAIR PROGRAM.

Mrs. Singleton moved, seconded by Mr. Aubuchon, the adoption of Bill 4959, as amended, as an ordinance. The following vote was recorded on the motion:
