SPECIAL ORDER OF BUSINESS

**LIQUOR LICENSE
EXPANSION**

A request for an expansion of the liquor license at Redbirds Sports Café and Billiards, 9085 Dunn Road, for a fundraising event on September 3 was received.

Stacy Mays, the licensee, was present to answer questions from the Council.

James Mays, the business owner, explained the parking lot will be used for a family event which will include a barbeque and bounce house for the children. One hundred percent of the parking lot proceeds will be donated to the Hazelwood Police Wives Association to support Officer Craig Tudor and his family. The indoor event will include door prizes. Ten percent of indoor sales will also be donated to the association. The expansion would allow the sale of aluminum bottles of beer on the patio. Patrons would be confined to the licensed area by orange fencing, trucks and trailers, the barbeque setup area, and tents. Recycle containers would be available. Parking would be available on the adjacent Bommarito lot which will be patrolled.

Mrs. Wolf noted a state license would be required to permit drinking of alcoholic beverages on the parking lot.

Mr. Mays responded application for a state license would be made once City approval is obtained.

Mrs. Hendon moved, seconded by Mr. Taylor, to grant the liquor license expansion for Redbirds Sports Café and Billiards, 9085 Dunn Road, to include the parking lot for a fundraising event on September 3 from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned at 4:15 p.m.
